Day 1: Arrival at Delhi to Shimla | A Beautiful Town **Encapsulated by Magical Misty Hills**

- Meet our representative at a pickup point in Delhi and get transferred to Shilma in an AC Volvo / Sedan/ SUV.
- Enjoy your overnight journey to Shimla fondly referred to as the 'Queen of Hills', Shimla, a very popular hill town of Himachal Pradesh.

Day 2: Sightseeing in Shimla and Excursion to Kufri | A **Haven for Nature Enthusiasts with Beautiful Hiking Trails**

- Start your day with a perfect breakfast at the hotel before heading out for the local sightseeing.
- You will first trek to the top of Jakhoo Hill to visit the ancient temple which is dedicated to Lord Hanuman.
- Then proceed to witness the Ridge Road located at the heart of Shimla which is a large space where all the cultural activities take place.
- You will also be visiting the Rashtrapati Niwas that once served as the residence of the



British Viceroy of India, and the Christ Church which is a parish in the Diocese of Amritsar.

- Visit the Mall Road lined with colorful shops where you can shop for souvenirs.
- Other places you can visit near Mall road are Town Hall, Gaiety Theatre and Scandal Point.
- You will then be proceeding towards Kufri, which passes through the splendid Hasan Valley and is known for its scenic beauty and pleasant weather.
- Visit the Himalayan Zoo which is home to wildlife like Felines, Antelopes, and other birds including Monal, the state bird of Himachal Pradesh.
- Return back to the hotel for an overnight stay in Shimla.

Day 3: Shimla to Manali Via Kullu Valley | Relish the Stunning Views of the Beautiful Valley of the Gods

- Start your morning with a delicious breakfast and get ready to depart to Manali.
- On the way when passing through the Mandi district, you will see the beautiful Pandoh Dam which offers views that are refreshing for the eyes, mind, and soul.
- You will then stop for sightseeing at Kullu which is a paradise for nature lovers.
- Visit the amazing Himalayan National Park with hosts a large variety of flora and fauna and the pious Raghunath Temple.
- You will also visit some of the other famous temples and landmarks in Kullu before continuing your journey towards Manali.
- Reach Manali and Check-in at the hotel.
- Dinner and overnight stay in Manali.

Day 4: Excursion to Solang Valley and Sightseeing in Manali | A Township Nestled in the Picturesque Beas **River Valley**

- After breakfast in the hotel, prepare yourself for the ultimate experience in Manali
- You will embark on the journey to the beautiful Solang Valley where you can take an



adventure stroll and enjoy adventure activities like Zorbing, Paragliding.

- Once back to Manali, you can also visit the Tibetan Monastery which is not only a place of worship but also a Tibetan Culture Centre.
- Also visit Jagatsukh, a small village that houses old Shikara-style temples and Vashisht Kund which is a famous hot water sulphur spring.
- Then proceed to the Hadimba Devi Temple which is an ancient temple (around 450 years old) that is dedicated to Hadimba Devi wife of one of the Pandava brothers Bhim.
- Go to Club House in the evening and spend leisure time at Mall Road.
- Return back to the hotel for an overnight stay in Manali.

Day 5 : Excursion to Rohtang Pass | Have a Unique Experience Driving Through the Walls of Snow

- After having an early breakfast enjoy a breathtaking drive to Snow Point on the road to Rohtang Pass (Closed on Tuesdays).
- Pass through the beautiful sights of glacier peaks, Lahaul Valley and the Chandra River. The twin peaks of Geypan are also visible from Rohtang.
- Rohtang Pass is covered with snow all around the year and lying at an elevation of 3978 m it offers a breathtaking view of the Himalayas.
- Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Manali.

Day 6: Delhi | Adios to the Snow-Clad Mountains

- Wake up in the morning and have a hearty breakfast, pack your bags and checkout from the hotel.
- Say Goodbye to the mountains and Proceed to Delhi with all the happy memories.
- On arrival in Delhi, you will be transferred to the airport/railway station to board the flight/Train back to your next destination

- Avoid using plastic bags and maintain the ecological balance of the destinations. Travelers littering may be fined.
- All international and domestic airfare, visa fees, airport tax, or any kind of insurance cover is not a part of the package.
- 5% GST is applicable to the package cost.
- Standard check in time at the hotels is 12 PM and check out time is 9 AM.
- The Vehicle will be available only till 8 PM.
- Meals other than those specified are an exclusion to the package.
- Vehicles will be provided as per the group size.
- ACs don't work in Hilly Areas as the climate is moderate.
- Hotels are subject to availability and if they are unavailable, guests will be accommodated in similar property.
- Monument entry fee and camera charges are not included in the package.
- Children above 5 years of age will be considered as adults only. There are no charges for children below 5 years of age.
- Govt. Approved ID is mandatory for each guest at the time of booking, and also upon arrival. PAN card will not be considered as a valid address proof.
- All foreign nationals must share their passport and visa details at the time of booking,



and also upon arrival.

- Prices might greatly vary on Blackout Dates(special dates like Diwali, Christmas, New Years, etc). In order to get the best rates for these days you can connect with us directly.
- The prices may vary based on the season time and the number of travellers travelling per day in a specific region as there is limited hotel availability in hilly areas.
- Any deviation from the planned route of vehicle at customer's request during the tour will be chargeable on per Km. basis.

- Personal expenses like portages, tips, laundry, mineral water etc. will not be accommodated in the package cost.

Confirmation Policy

Cancellation Policy

- If cancellation is made 30 days or more before the date of travel, 25.0% of total booking cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellation is made between 15 days to 30 days before the date of travel, 50.0% of total booking cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellation is made within 15 days before the date of travel, total booking cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
